Our Master of Public Administration (MPA) Internship Program is Atlantic Canada's only MPA program offering a paid work experience. It's designed with employers in mind.

Backed by CAPPA (Canadian Association of Programs in Public Administration) accreditation, curriculum is built around five core competencies: critical thinking, leadership, engagement, ethics, and communication.
