To ensure that students are receiving appropriate supervision and guidance when performing either full or partial History and Physical (H&P) Examinations, at least one Clinical Procedure Log entry for each discipline for clerks must be recorded, starting for the class of 2023 at the beginning of their clerkship year in September 2021.

Traditional Block Clerks will have to complete at least one H&P log entry for observed complete or partial H&P in each of the clinical disciplines; thus, they would be expected to complete at least one log entry in the following blocks: Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Family Medicine, Psychiatry, and Surgery. This log entry should be completed by the end of the rotation.

In LICD experiences, clerks will be expected to complete at least 6 such log entries for observed H&P throughout their 48-week experiences, and these entries can be in any discipline. LICD students are encouraged to address different domains of care with their log entries. These log entries should be completed by the end of the 48 week LICD experience.
