

Dal Med NB Health Research Award Application Guide Spring 2025

Description: The Dal Med NB Health Research Award is awarded annually to support the research and research teaching mandate of the Faculty of Medicine at DMNB. There is a maximum of \$100k, available for open competition.

Eligibility: The Dal Med NB Health Research Award is open to individuals based in New Brunswick, who hold a current appointment with the Faculty of Medicine, Dalhousie University.

Preference will be given to submissions where matching funds have already been secured and/ or to supplement established funding.

Application Due: March 24, 2025

Review Process: Applications will be reviewed by a committee, which will include the Assistant Dean, Research, DMNB and the Research Manager, DMNB.

Application Guidelines: The application should be sent to dmnb.research@dal.ca as a single pdf document.

The application should include the following:

1. Title of Project and Project Overview: (approximately 250 – 500 words)
 - Identify the Principal and Co-Investigators
 - Provide a lay summary/brief description of the research activity
2. Funding Requested:
 - Total dollar value of the request
 - Matching funds and/ or established funding
 - Brief justification for the request (Approximately 250 words)
3. Summary of how these funds will impact: (Approximately 250 – 500 words)
 - i. Research
 - ii. Researchers, Students and/or patients
 - iii. The greater community, specifically the DMNB campus and/or Dalhousie as a whole

Successful award recipients may be asked to do a short (3-minute) presentation at the annual DMNB Research Celebration in November, 2025. Information contained in the applications received from successful award recipients may be included in Dalhousie University reports.
