### *Hunter Humanities Award Graduating Class 2024*

The Hunter Humanities Award will be presented to a graduating medical student at Dalhousie who has made an outstanding contribution to the concept and spirit of the humanities in medicine and demonstrated the humanistic qualities of caring and compassion in the care of their patients. The award, \$1000, has been generously contributed by a Dalhousie Graduate, Dr. Mary Hunter, retired from anesthesiology practice in Toronto.

Nominations should include details of the depth of involvement in the humanities, the variety of activities, and any humanities publications, scholarly or creative products. Any involvement that captures the spirit of the humanities can be identified and does not have to be within the Humanities Program. They may include activities in other parts of the medical program and the community.

Students can nominate themselves or a fellow student. Faculty are also invited to nominate students. Submit Nomination Letter, letters of support (maximum three), supporting background information (projects/activities related), and abbreviated 2-page CV to [medhuman@dal.ca](mailto:medhuman@dal.ca).
