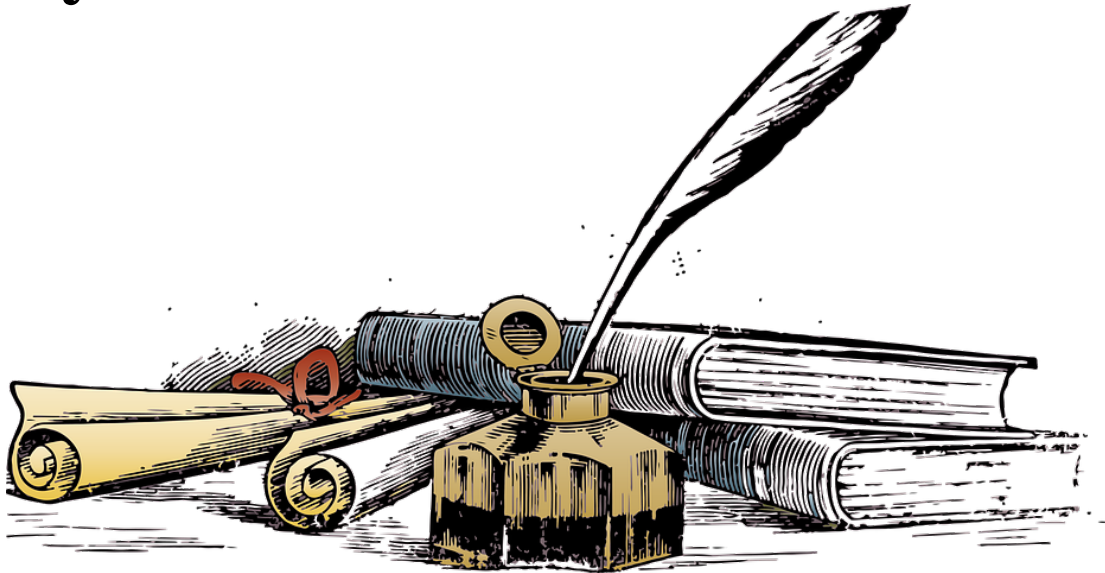




Cynthia Davis Prize for Writing



Medical students and resident doctors of Dalhousie University are invited to submit their work to the 2024 Cynthia Davis Prize for Writing.

This year, the theme will be on kindness and belonging in medicine. Elaborate on a situation, whether real or imagined, about these themes in the context of healthcare. Then write about it! The writing could be in the form of a story, essay, or poem. Your work will be evaluated on your ideas and organization, and whether the content of your work illuminates the human condition in the area of mental, physical or spiritual health. The winner will be imaginative, showing a unique style and voice. The quality of writing will also be judged for its flow, originality and relevance. Please include this as double-spaced 12 pt Times New Roman. The word limit is 2500 words.

First prize is \$1000 and runners up will receive \$200.

The winner and runners up will be announced and have the opportunity to read from their submission at the Creating Space Conference the first weekend in May, 2024.
