Overview

Off the Charts is a four-week online interactive elective designed for healthcare learners and professionals across disciplines. Through poetic and theatrical prompts combined with material arts, this workshop explores narrative medicine and embodied bookmaking practices to enhance reflective capacity and deepen patient-provider communication beyond the medical chart.

Participants will engage with patient experiences that often remain unspoken in clinical encounters—yet profoundly impact outcomes, adherence, and well-being. The fusion of text and sculptural book-objects offers creative, inter-subjective modes of expression that go far beyond standard history-taking.
