The Shirley Case Leadership Award has four objectives:

- To draw public attention to the full scope of global citizenship and engagement activities;
- To inspire individuals to continue their involvement in the international cooperation movement; and
- To honour the memory of Shirley Case

The award will be presented at the gala evening dinner on June 13th, in conjunction with the ACIC Annual General Meeting & Symposium to be held in Charlottetown, PEI. The winner will receive a cash prize of \$500 CAD as well as a plaque to commemorate the award.
