HIV Testing and Disclosure: A Public Health or Legal Matter?

Recent HIV surveillance data indicate there are over 60,000 Canadians living with HIV, approximately 25% of whom are unaware of their HIV status (PHAC, 2012). As indicated in the current literature on HIV testing, knowing one's HIV status can serve as the impetus for timely access to care, treatment and support, as well as the prevention of the onward transmission of the virus (Gahagan et al, 2010; Gahagan et al, 2011). The focus of this talk is in relation to the recent Supreme Court decision on the issue of criminalization of HIV non-disclosure and the public health and health promotion implications of this decision on HIV testing, particularly on the lives of women in Canada.
