

## **The Samuel R. McLaughlin Fellowship Terms and Criteria**

To be considered for the Samuel R. McLaughlin Fellowship, the following criteria must be met by the applicants:

1. Must be Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada, and currently registered with Dalhousie University in a Residency Training Program.
2. Must undertake to follow plan of study outlined in the proposal for fellowship; preference will be given to those who will be studying at an institute other than their own.
3. Shall submit a progress report mid-term to completion of training.
4. Preference will be given to those with an offer of a faculty appointment at a Canadian Institution.
5. The candidate will have an aptitude for teaching/research, confirmed in supporting letters of reference.
6. Candidates will be completing a residency program and will not use the fellowship to study or write an examination for residency certification.
7. If the candidate does not complete the Fellowship as per the terms of the proposal, s/he will be required to repay some or all monies to the McLaughlin Fellowship Fund. The Awarding Body will review the circumstances of the situation, and a determination will be made whether the entire or partial amount will be repaid.

Selection of winners for the McLaughlin Scholarship will be based on:

- a) Year of training (only current PGY2- PGY6 residents may be nominated)
- b) The candidate's demonstrated abilities and aptitude for academic work (CV)
- c) The quality of the proposal for the course of study / research. In the case of research proposals, this includes an assessment of the quality of the research itself and the candidate's role in it.
- d) Content of the reference letters
- e) Study outside Dalhousie (preference given to those studying outside Dalhousie)
- f) Existence of an offer of appointment at a Canadian institution after completion of training.

- 3) Two reference letters. References should comment especially on the resident's aptitude and demonstrated abilities in teaching and research.
