Terms and Criteria

This bursary is open to Nova Scotia-based trainees entering their second year of residency training or above. Preference will be given to those who have contributed to policy and/or program development in the area of physician well-being.

The applicant should provide a completed application page (below) AND the following additional information:

- Cover Letter from the resident describing any contributions made to policy and/or program
 development in the area of physician well-being or plans for future involvement in this area.
 The letter and summary should not exceed two pages.
- 2. Demonstration of financial need
- 3. Abbreviated CV (not to exceed 2 pages)
- 4. Two letters of reference; one of these must be from the candidate's program director attesting to their good academic standing.

Selection of winners of the Bluteau Caseley Wealth Management Group MD Bursary will be based on the following criteria:

- a. The candidate's record of performance in residency
- b. The candidate's contributions in the area of physician health and well-being
- c. The degree to which the bursary will contribute to future involvement in the area of physician health and well-being.
- d. Content of the reference letters
