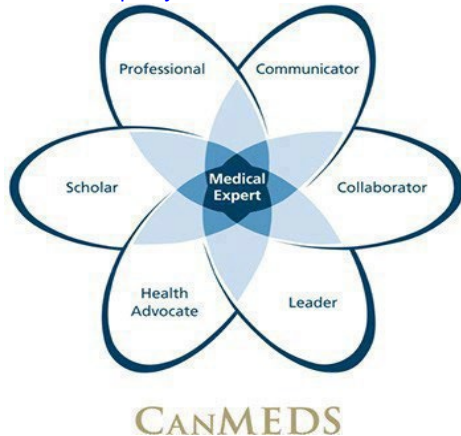
#### Module Completion:
