

The Ross Stewart Smith Fellowship in Medical Research

Terms and Criteria

This fellowship is open to residents of exceptional ability in any year of their program following graduation from the Dalhousie Faculty of Medicine. The research may be in clinical medicine or in the basic medical sciences.

The applicant should provide a completed application page (below) AND the following additional information:

1. Cover Letter from the resident with a lay summary of the proposed research project. The letter and summary should not exceed two pages.
2. One full copy of the research proposal, including a research budget
3. Candidate CV
4. Two letters of reference including one from the proposed research supervisor supporting the resident's application

Selection of winners of the Ross Stewart Smith Memorial Fellowship in Medical Research will be based on the following criteria:

- a. The candidate's demonstrated abilities and aptitude for research (CV)
- b. The quality of the research proposal (including both the clarity of the summary and the scientific merit of the proposal)
- c. The candidate's role in the proposed project (with preference given to those with greater involvement)
- d. The degree to which the fellowship will contribute to the project
- e. Content of the reference letters
