## DMNB BUILDING

### MAIN FLOOR LOUNGE

The main floor of the building holds a lounge with a combination of individual study cubicles and tables.

First come, first serve.



### TUTORIAL ROOMS

Found on the bottom floor of the DMNB building are 4 tutorial rooms that can be booked when not in use for curriculum. To reserve a room, send a calendar invite to [dmnb.study@dal.ca](mailto:dmnb.study@dal.ca), specifying the room number you'd like to request.



### LRC - CLINIC ROOMS

Outside of curriculum, you can book the clinic rooms to be used for study. There is a desk and chair in each room and many of the rooms have great sunlight!

## UNIVERSITY OF NEW BRUNSWICK SAINT JOHN

### HANS W. KLOHN COMMONS

There are a number of study rooms that can be booked using your UNB Credentials at the commons.

To book rooms (max. 3 hours in length):

- Click Hans W. Klohn Commons
- Select the room and times you want then submit and log in with your UNB credentials
- Click Continue to submit a booking request for the booking to be complete. Note: If you do not receive an email from the system with a confirmation message, your booking is NOT complete.

### SHARED QUIET AREAS

Within the commons building there are designated quiet areas for study. These are found on the second floor and are first come first serve. No booking necessary!

### GANONG HALL AND HAZEN HALL BREAKOUT ROOMS

To book a breakout room (max. 2 hours in length):

- Use the QR codes located outside each breakout room **or** visit the website: [bookings.unb.ca/portal/](https://bookings.unb.ca/portal/) (Login with UNB credentials required)
- Once logged in, on the left-hand menu click “Rooms”. Click the “Additional room criteria” drop-down menu and select “Breakout Room(s)”, this will display all room options for Ganong Hall and Hazen Hall.
- Click each room for room characteristics and details.
- Once you have identified which room is appropriate for your use, click “New Booking” and proceed with selecting the date and timeframe required. Additionally, booking can be made anytime by selecting the calendar icon.
- At the bottom of the page, click “Book Room”
- Confirmation of your booking will appear on the screen when complete.
