Students completing rotations outside of their home campus, (outside being considered greater than 100 km outside of exam site), will be released from service at 6:00 pm two days prior to the MCQ or OSCE, whichever comes first. There will be no on-call or additional service responsibilities. Students will not be expected to return to that service following the exams.

Students completing rotations within 100 km of exam site will be released from service at 6:00 pm the night prior to the MCQ or OSCE, whichever comes first. There will be no on-call or additional service responsibilities. Students will not be expected to return to that service following the exams.

To maximize time on service, students write December and June exams at the exam site closest to the location of their last rotation preceding the exam. A list of current exam sites is available from the UGME office. ■
