The Undergraduate Medical Education program follows Dalhousie University policy with respect to storm closures for Med 1 and 2 curriculum activities. Please check the Dalhousie website for closure announcements at www.dal.ca.

During times of inclement weather when the university has <u>not</u> closed and classes are <u>not</u> cut short, students traveling off-campus to Skilled Clinician sessions or Electives are advised to use their best judgment in deciding to attend. If you do not feel it is safe to travel, it is your responsibility to notify your tutor/preceptor and the UGME office. If the University is closed, students must use their own discretion as to whether or not they deem it safe to travel to any off-campus Electives location.

Med 3 and 4 students are expected to use their best judgment and attend their clinical placements if possible.
