### **Purpose:**

#### Goals:

- To review and discuss resident performance issues.

- To discuss the performance of a "Resident in Academic Difficulty" and develop and implement appropriate enhanced learning plans including terms of remediation and academic probation.
- To adhere to the Faculty of Medicine Postgraduate Policy regarding suspension or dismissal of a resident from the Family Medicine resident training program.
- To discuss Postgraduate program issues requiring detailed discussion prior to presenting the topic to the Residency Program Committee.
- To ensure that each resident in the program is reviewed for readiness for promotion and transition to practice.
