

Residency Training Executive Committee Terms of Reference

Purpose:

- To provide a mechanism for review of residents and faculty performance issues.
- To be a working sub-committee of the Residency Training Committee.

Goals:

- To review and approve resident requests submitted to the program.
- To review and discuss resident performance issues.
- To discuss concerns regarding teaching faculty.
- To discuss the performance of a “Resident in Academic Difficulty” and develop and implement appropriate educational plans including terms of remediation and academic probation.
- To adhere to the Faculty of Medicine Postgraduate Policy regarding suspension or dismissal of a resident from the Family Medicine resident training program.
- To discuss Postgraduate program issues requiring detailed discussion prior to presenting the topic to the Residency Training Committee.
