

## **Contraception**

The resident will be able to describe:

- 1. Effectiveness of common contraceptive methods
- 2. Side effects, risks and benefits of each method in various age groups
- 3. Contraindications for hormonal contraceptives
- 4. Counseling patients with side effects of oral contraceptives
- 5. Approach to counseling women and men from young teenagers to middle aged adults
- 6. Appropriate History/questions
- 7. Appropriate physical exam
- 8. Controversies including ethical issues

The presenter will use a series of cases addressing the following:

- 1. Contraceptive counseling for challenging patients (young teens, those with multiple partners)
- 2. Demonstration of various methods and devices
