

Diabetes

At the completion of this seminar the resident will be able to:

- 1. Appropriately screen for diabetes.
- 2. Counsel patients about their diagnosis, importance of lifestyle modification and appropriate follow-up.
- 3. Initiate and monitor regular follow-up with particular attention to glycemic control and screening for complications.
- 4. Refer when appropriate (e.g. Diabetes education, ophthalmologic screening, foot care, endocrinology)
- 5. Initiate appropriate pharmacologic treatment when indicated and adjust that treatment to achieve glycemic control, adapting this approach to the individual patient.
- 6. Describe indications for initiating insulin and an approach to doing so
- 7. Advise patients about coping with intercurrent illness.
- 8. Recognize and appropriately initiate management of DKA.
