

Life-Long Learning with an Emphasis on Therapeutics

Goal

To prepare residents for the transition from an environment where their learning has been largely structured by others to an environment where they will be completely responsible for both the scheduling and the choice of learning modes.

The resident will be able to:

- 1. Describe their own learning style/preferences
- 2. Describe behaviors and approaches to learning of physicians who successfully incorporate change into their practice
- Recognize the need to actively structure their professional life to include adequate opportunities for peer interaction and reflective learning as well as formal courses, journal reading etc.
