

Low Back Pain

At the completion of the seminar the resident will be able to, when dealing with a patient with low back pain:

- 1. Differentiate serious underlying causes (e.g. cauda equina syndrome, AAA, cancer, renal calculus) from mechanical low back pain.
- 2. Demonstrate appropriate levels of investigation
- 3. Demonstrate appropriate conservative management of mechanical low back pain:
 - a. Explanation, reassurance, follow-up
 - b. Advice re simple analgesic use
 - c. Support for early return to activity and work
 - d. Advice re role for ergonomics and exercise in prevention of recurrence
