

Osteoporosis

The resident will be able to:

- 1. Have a strategy to incorporating screening for osteoporosis into their patient's periodic health exam considering the major and minor risk factors for osteoporosis.
- 2. Offer advice as to primary prevention of osteoporosis and related fractures.
- 3. Determine a persons' absolute fracture risk and use this to present appropriate treatment strategies.
- 4. Identify the secondary causes of osteoporosis and list appropriate investigations for persons newly diagnosed with osteoporosis.
- 5. Discuss the various pharmacological treatment options for osteoporosis.
