 - Evidence-based benefits of conducting the periodic health examination specifically the Level of Evidence used by the Canadian Task Force on Preventive Health Care.
 - b. Priorities for preventive services which to recommend from individual patients and which to discourage to prevent harm from inappropriate testing by:
 - i. Determining the burden of suffering caused by the condition; and,
 - ii. Determining how good the screening test(s) is (are) for that condition
- 2. The delivery of preventive services efficiently in the context of a busy family practice setting
