The resident will be able to:

- 1. Describe a systematic approach to the diagnosis of common skin conditions.
- 2. Accurately describe skin conditions.
- 3. Diagnose and manage common skin conditions presenting to Family Physicians including: Acne, Atopic dermatitis, Herpes simplex, Herpes zoster, Impetigo, Insect bites, Lichen planus, Molluscum contagiosum, Pityriasis rosea, Psoriasis, Scabies, Seborrheic dermatitis, Skin malignancies, Tinea infections, Viral exanthem.
- 4. Diagnose and manage common disorders of nails and hair.
- 5. The resident will be able to describe:
 - a. common dermatological presentations of non-infectious systemic disease and
 - b. Common dermatological presentations of infectious illnesses.
