The resident will be able to:

1. Describe a systematic approach to the diagnosis of common skin conditions.
2. Accurately describe skin conditions.
3. Diagnose and manage common skin conditions presenting to Family Physicians including: Acne, Atopic dermatitis, Herpes simplex, Herpes zoster, Impetigo, Insect bites, Lichen planus, Molluscum contagiosum, Pityriasis rosea, Psoriasis, Scabies, Seborrheic dermatitis, Skin malignancies, Tinea infections, Viral exanthem.
4. Diagnose and manage common disorders of nails and hair.
5. The resident will be able to describe:
 - a. common dermatological presentations of non-infectious systemic disease and
 - b. Common dermatological presentations of infectious illnesses.
