

FM-PGY1 Clinical Learning Experiences

Placements	Duration	Location/Notes
Core Family Medicine	12 weeks	Including scheduled time to complete shifts in the emergency department (minimum amount is 1/week).
Emergency Medicine	4 weeks	Core experience.
General Medicine	8 weeks	Core experience.
General Surgery	4 weeks	Including consultation services to Emergency Department and clinics (including minor procedures, breast evaluation, follow-up).
Obstetrics/Gynecology	8 weeks	Clinics, case room, and emergency consults.
Orthopedics	4 weeks	Clinics and 'first call' to the emergency room.
Pediatrics	4 weeks	Clinics, unit-based, and emergency consults.
Community Family Medicine	8 weeks	Residents will live and work in a small Maritime community where they will do comprehensive family medicine with rural trauma team call with a preceptor who includes emergency care in their practice.

FM-PGY2 Clinical Learning Experiences

Placements	Duration	Location/Notes
Cardiac Care Unit	4 weeks	Including emergency consultation service.
Core Family Medicine	16 weeks	Including 30+ half-day clinical experiences in a combination of anesthesiology, orthopaedics, psychiatry, plastic surgery, and emergency medicine.
Geriatric Medicine	4 weeks	In/out-patient settings including emergency consultation service.
Palliative Care	4 weeks	In-patient care, home consultations including emergency consultation service.
Community Family Medicine	16 weeks	Residents will return to the same small Maritime community from Year 1 continuing to work with the family physician who practices at least one shift per week in an emergency department
Emergency Medicine	4 weeks	Core experience: combination of day, evening, and night shifts.

Placements	Duration	Location/Notes
Cardiac Care Unit	4 weeks	Including emergency consultation service.
Emergency Medicine	16 weeks	Core experience.
Family Medicine	8 weeks	Residents would spend 2.5 days per week in family medicine and 2.5 days per week would be dedicated to shifts in the emergency department.
Intensive Care Unit	8 weeks	Including emergency consultation service.
Pediatric Critical Care	4 weeks	Pediatric emergency medicine alternating with Pediatric anesthesia, critical care transport team, and trauma team call.
Community Family Medicine / Emergency Medicine	8 weeks	Residents will return to the same small Maritime community from Years 1 and 2 where they will acquire 2.5 days per week family medicine experience with rural trauma team call and 2.5 days per week in emergency medicine
