At the completion of this seminar the resident will:

- 1) Have an awareness of common occupationally related injuries and less common but significant occupationally related diseases.
- 2) Have an approach to diagnosis and assessing causality in these conditions.
- 3) Be aware of reporting requirements and appropriate communication with Workers Compensation Boards, employers and other third parties relating to:
 - a. Fitness for work
 - b. Work-related injuries and disease
 - c. Return to work after work-related and non-work-related illness and injury
- 4) Be able to appropriately recommend work absence or restriction and assist in appropriate return to work planning in common occupationally related diseases and injuries.
