Background

In order to ensure that residents' privacy and confidentiality are maintained during training; respecting the power differential and boundaries that exist between faculty and family medicine residents; the following principles must be followed:

- 1. Early in their residency, residents and their families should be encouraged to obtain a primary health care provider outside of the Postgraduate Family Medicine program.
- 2. Faculty involved in assessing the resident may provide care to residents and their families in **emergency situations only** if no alternative provider is available but should request that the resident and their family establish an on-going relationship with another primary health care provider if they have not already done so.
- 3. Any emergency care of residents and their families must be documented in the same manner as other patients.
