Assignment of Educational Experiences

The Family Medicine residency program strives to provide reasonable choice and flexibility for residents as they select their educational experiences for each year of the residency program. The principles used in the assignment of educational experiences include: appropriateness of educational experience, resident preferences, identified resident learning needs and resource implications on an individual, site and program basis. Once the educational experiences have been set and provided to the residents, there is a concentrated effort to maintain this schedule.

It is recognized that due to a variety of circumstances such as, but not limited to, leaves of absence, preceptor availability or resource mal-distribution, changes in the schedules may be required, sometimes with short notice. The residency program reserves the right to make these changes if required.
