BRIAN M. CHANDLER LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD IN MEDICAL EDUCATION 2023

Description

Initiated in 1999, the Brian M. Chandler Lifetime Achievement Award in Medical Education is presented to senior members of the Department of Medicine who have demonstrated leadership in education making significant contributions to teaching, learning and educational development beyond their role as a clinician and lecturer throughout their career.

Eligibility

- All Department of Medicine (DoM) physicians who have or have had a leadership role. The leadership role does not have to be a formerly named leadership position.
- Award recipients cannot be re-nominated for three (3) years.
- Any member is invited to submit a nomination. Self nominations not eligible.

Process

Nomination packages must include:

- **One nomination letter**
 - Detail why this individual is deserving of this recognition. Provide specific examples and dates to support the nomination (max 2 pages).
- **One letter of support**
- **Abbreviated current CV** for the nominee.

Selection

The Awards & Recognition Committee will determine the award recipient. The award will be presented at the annual awards event. Nominations will be kept for two years.

Deadline – May 1 annually
