Department of Medicine Resident Research Publication Award

PURPOSE:

The main purpose of this award is to publicly recognize the research publication achievements of Department of Medicine (DoM) residents. Presentation of this award also aims to encourage residents to pursue publication of their work.

There are two Resident Research Publication Awards. There is normally one award for PGY1-3 residents, and one award for current CIP residents and PGY4-6 residents.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Awards are presented for achievement during the current academic year (July 1-June 30). All DoM residents are eligible to apply. Ordinarily individuals would receive an award no more than once per category.

AWARDS:

Consideration of awards will be given on an annual basis; however, depending on the merit of the nomination(s), they will not necessarily be given every year. Recipients of these awards will usually be announced to Department members at the annual DoM Spring Party.

The Awards consist of the presentation of a plaque/certificate and a cash award of \$500.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

This is a self-nomination process for residents, with the aim of providing practice in completing applications and identifying/promoting your research activities.

Please submit an electronic copy of:

- a completed nomination form (available from DoMResearch@nshealth.ca)
- a letter of support from one of your faculty supervisors in the DoM (or your Program Director), to be submitted directly by the faculty member to DoMResearch@nshealth.ca

NOMINATION DEADLINE:

Nomination form and letter must be submitted to <u>DoMResearch@nshealth.ca</u> by end of day on the second Friday in May, annually.

AWARD REVIEW PROCESS:

All nominations will be reviewed by the DoM Resident Research Committee using the criteria identified on the nomination form.
