DoM EXCELLENCE IN QUALITY & INNOVATION AWARD 2023

Description

Initiated in 2019, this award was created to acknowledge excellence in quality and innovation among department members and to encourage their continued efforts in participating in quality improvement in the Faculty of Medicine and Nova Scotia Health.

Eligibility

- Department of Medicine members who have made a significant contribution to quality and innovation in education, research and/or patient care over the last 2 years.
- Award recipients cannot be re-nominated for three (3) years unless there has been a significant new project.
- Any member is invited to submit a nomination. Self nominations are not eligible.

Process

Nomination packages must include:

- **One nomination letter**
 - Detail why this individual is deserving of this recognition. Provide specific examples and dates to support the nomination (max 2 pages).
 - Describe in detail the nominee's accomplishments in a quality and/or innovation project over the last 2 years, including the status of the project, outcomes/impact of the project and presentations or publication related to the project.
 - Recognize the nominee's contributions to quality and innovation at the departmental, faculty, institutional and national or international levels.
 - Include the name and email address of a second supporting nominator. The committee may reach out to the supporting nominator for further information.
- **Abbreviated current CV** for the nominee.



Selection

The Awards & Recognition Committee will determine the award recipient. The award will be presented at the annual awards event. Nominations will be kept for two years.

Deadline – May 1 annually
