

## OUTSTANDING CONSULTANT TRAINEE AWARD

### DESCRIPTION

This award will be given annually to a resident who stands out from their peers in providing the highest quality patient care as part of an integrated interdisciplinary team.

### ELIGIBILITY

Senior medical resident or fellow from a Department of Medicine subspecialty.

### CRITERIA

Nominees must demonstrate at least one, or a combination of the following criteria:

- Excellent communication skills and interdisciplinary collaboration.
- Able to balance and prioritize the many demands while keeping patient care needs at the forefront.
- Excellent teacher as well as a motivated learner.
- Demonstrates an ability to remain calm under pressure and can multitask effectively without being distracted from the important task at hand.
- Knowledgeable and evidence-based with regard to clinical decision making, and yet demonstrate appropriate humility with families and other health care professionals.

Any faculty, staff or resident is invited to submit a nomination.

Nomination packages must include the following:

- A nomination letter stating how the individual has met the above criteria.
- A second letter of support from one other faculty or staff member.

### SELECTION

The Awards Committee will determine the award recipient

The award will be presented at the Annual Spring Party of the Department of Medicine.

The winner will receive a plaque.

All the other nominations will be kept for two years if appropriate.
