- The Camp Hill Hospital treated **1400** people in the **first 24 hours**
- Students from Dalhousie Medical School, some of whom had started just 3 months earlier, were rushed in to help treat the 9,000 injured
- Dalhousie Medical Student, Florence Murray, found herself administering anaesthetic for the first time. The **next day** she became the official anaesthetist at the YMCA emergency hospital
