Comprised of 162 staff, including Dalhousie professors, senior students and nurses

- First located in Shorncliffe, Kent, then in Le Havre, France in 1916, and finally in a chateau in Armentières, France in 1917, where they treated German prisoners of war and Canadian soldiers
- **Dr. John Stewart** was among those that returned; he became Dean of Medicine for the faculty in 1919 until 1932
