Applications are invited for up to two positions as Gynecologic Oncologist and Faculty Member in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Dalhousie University and the Nova Scotia Health Authority. This position is part of a group practice located at the Victoria General Site in Halifax, Nova Scotia. The incumbent will hold a continuing academic appointment with Dalhousie University at a rank (Assistant, Associate or Professor) commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Minimum requirements will include an MD plus FRCSC or equivalent certification and having completed a fellowship program in Gynecology Oncology. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to the university teaching program, conduct or participate in biomedical or clinical research, and assume some administrative responsibilities. The call expectations are 1 in 4, but will be adjusted based on the FTE of this position. The Department will give preference to applicants with a demonstrated aptitude and interest in research.
