The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Dalhousie University, has a locum opportunity for a Gynecologic Oncologist, commencing in January 2017.

This is a full-time locum opportunity, but an FTE less than 1.0 would be considered. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to work in an academic setting, providing care to women in the Maritime region. The call schedule is 1 in 3 or 4, and is organized one week at a time.

This position is part of a group practice, located in the Central Zone of the NSHA, Victoria General Site in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Halifax is a coastal city on the eastern seaboard of Canada. In addition to its beautiful oceanfront views, the city offers its residents the best qualities of both a smaller city (friendly citizens, safe neighbourhoods), and being that it is the cultural hub of the Maritimes it also offers the amenities usually reserved for larger centers (multiple Universities, a vibrant arts scene and great dining options).
