NEW ASSESSMENT CUES FEATURE IN ONE45

- ◆ One45 has launched a new “Assessment Cues” feature.
- ◆ Basic details can now be included to cue you to recall the encounter to be assessed. For example, “infant with respiratory distress”.
- ◆ The cues SHOULD NOT include any identifying information like names, specific ages, K numbers, etc.
- ◆ The cue is an optional field.
- ◆ Remember, to provide the most effective coaching EPAs are best completed in the moment or as soon as possible after the encounter.
