Pharmacology Examination Committee Guidelines

- These guidelines apply to MSc defenses, PhD defenses, and PhD Comprehensive examination committees.
- The Department of Pharmacology follows the FGS "[X. Thesis Regulations](#)" for all MSc and PhD defenses.
- In all Pharmacology examinations two readers/examiners are required in addition to the supervisor(s), chair, and external examiner (PhD defense only)
- The Department of Pharmacology has the following additional restrictions for the two Dalhousie examiners:
 - At least one examiner must be from the Department of Pharmacology
 - The second examiner can be within or outside of the Department of Pharmacology
 - Examiners may or may not be from the student's supervisory committee
 - At least one of the examiners should not be in conflict of interest with the project & thesis being examined. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - not being a co-author on publications within the thesis
 - not being a co-applicant on funding used within the thesis
