Keynote: Psychedelics for Mood Disorders: A Brave New World

Psychedelics have reemerged as promising treatments for a variety of brain disorders. Ketamine and psilocybin have shown incredible promise for mood disorders specifically with rapid and robust antidepressant effects noted in preliminary clinical trials. This presentation will discuss recent advances in the research and development of ketamine and psilocybin. A broad overview of evidence will be presented followed by presentation of primary data evaluating ketamine and psilocybin for treatment resistant depression within major depressive disorder and bipolar disorder. Challenges, limitations and ethical considerations will also be discussed with a focus on the evolving Canadian landscape of psychedelic research. Progress, pitfalls and potential will be explored followed by discussion of the potential future role of psychedelics in clinical practice.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Dr. Joshua Rosenblat is a staff psychiatrist, associate professor and clinician-researcher at Toronto Western Hospital and the University of Toronto. Dr. Rosenblat's research focus is conducting clinical trials to identify and evaluate novel interventions for mood disorders that may substantially improve patient outcomes. Specific research programs currently underway include clinical trials evaluating ketamine and psilocybin assisted therapy for bipolar and unipolar depression. Dr. Rosenblat has authored and co-authored >300 peer-reviewed papers and has received numerous grants and awards from local, provincial, and federal granting agencies (totaling over \$30 million in peer reviewed funding) that are supporting several ongoing studies in his lab.
