Department of Surgery Research Committee

The DOS Research Committee will vet all grants submitted. The Department of Surgery looks favorably on all research which drives autonomous strong programs, but also research that has the capacity to include other members of the Department through collaboration; such as joint hiring of technical/research staff, sharing of equipment or space, sharing outcome data analysis or managers, administrative staff needs.

Seed Grants will be awarded up to \$50,000.00 per year.

Eligibility:

• To be within first 5 years of appointment.

Application:

- Abstract not to exceed 250 words.
- Cover Page: Principle Applicant(s) Name, Appointment and contact information.
- Support Letter from your Division Head outlining protected time status.
- One Reference letter from member of faculty supporting feasibility and support/mentoring available to you.
- Description of Project with deliverables and key objectives. (3-5 pages)
- Amount of money requested.
- Detailed itemized budget or budget narrative describing how monies will be spent (not to exceed one page).
- My common CV for PI. CHIR biosketch for all co-applicants
- Successful applicant must provide a progress report and be prepared to present to the committee within 18 months of disbursement of funds.

Match Funding: Will be awarded up to \$50,000.00

Eligibility:

• Open to any member of the Department who has successfully been awarded monies from an external granting agency requiring match funding.

Application:

- Cover Page: Principle Applicant(s) Name, Appointment and contact information.
- Copy of Success grant and announcement award letter.
- Letter detailing monies requested.
- Successful applicant will be asked to come to present to the research committee the details of their research project and other ongoing research activities.

Bridge Funding: Award up to \$50,000.00

Eligibility:

• Open to all members of faculty with existing research dollars and actively writing grants to secure future funding.

Application:

- Cover Page: Principle Applicant(s) Name, contact information.
- Detailed report on funding gap (letter from external granting agency with score and constructive comments) copy of newel grant application or new application.
- Detailed itemized budget or budget narrative describing how monies will be spent (not to exceed one page).
- Successful applicant will be asked to come to present to the research committee the details of their research project and other ongoing research activities.
