- Applicants must demonstrate a clear interest or track record in global surgery or its related disciplines. The award will be transferred directly to the successful applicant. Each award is valued at \$5000. Please submit the application with necessary attachments (<u>Canadian Common CV</u> and Letters of support) via email to the <u>GSO coordinator</u>.
