The Global Surgery Office (GSO) awards a small number of grants to residents and staff to support international and local research. Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- Active student or faculty within the Department of Surgery
- Residents must have at least one or more year of training remaining
- Students must have a faculty mentor within the Department of Surgery
- Applicants must demonstrate a clear interest or track record in global surgery or its related disciplines

The award will be transferred directly to the successful applicant. Each award is valued at \$5000. Please submit the application with necessary attachments ([Canadian Common CV](#) and Letters of support) via email to the [GSO coordinator](#).

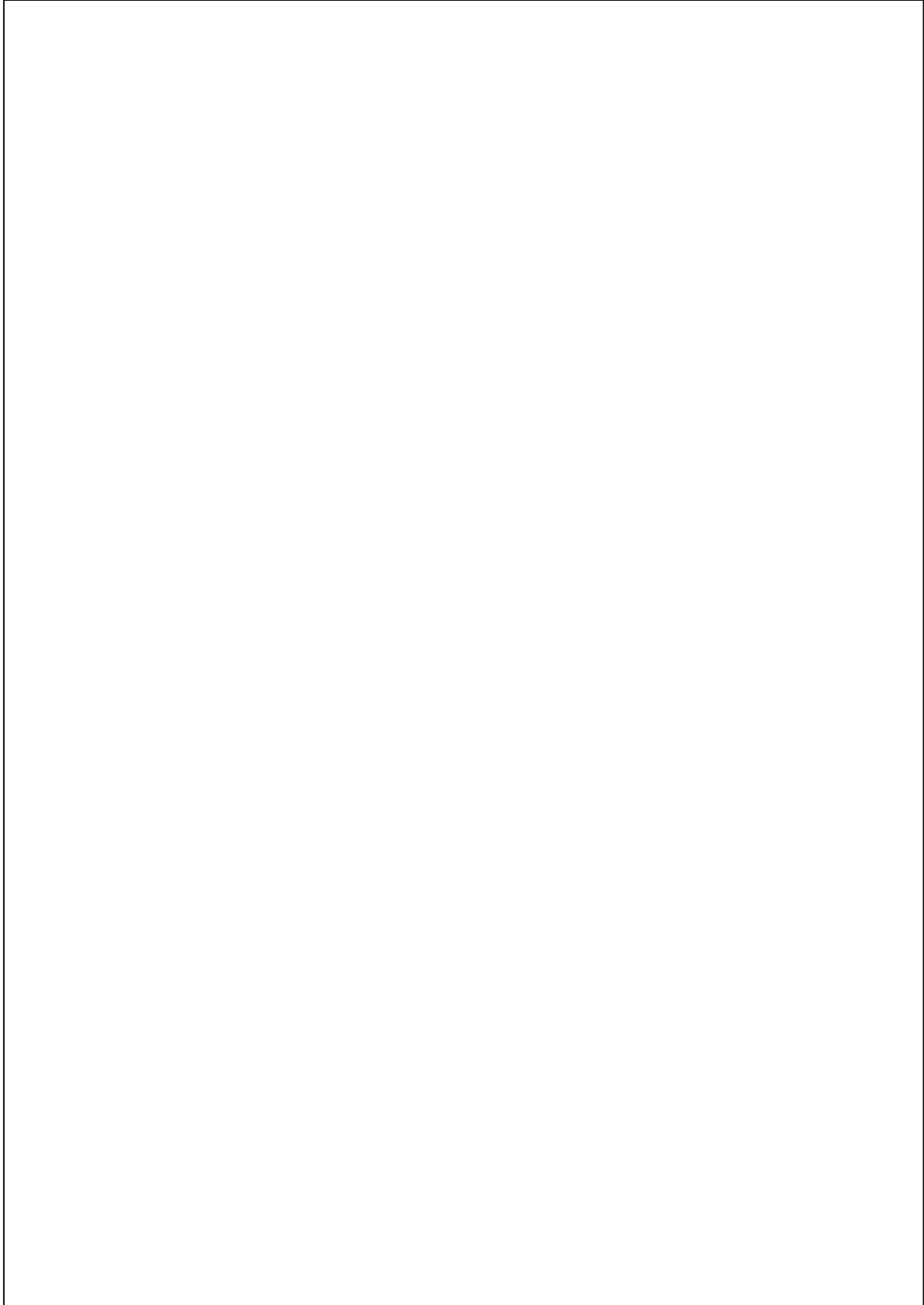

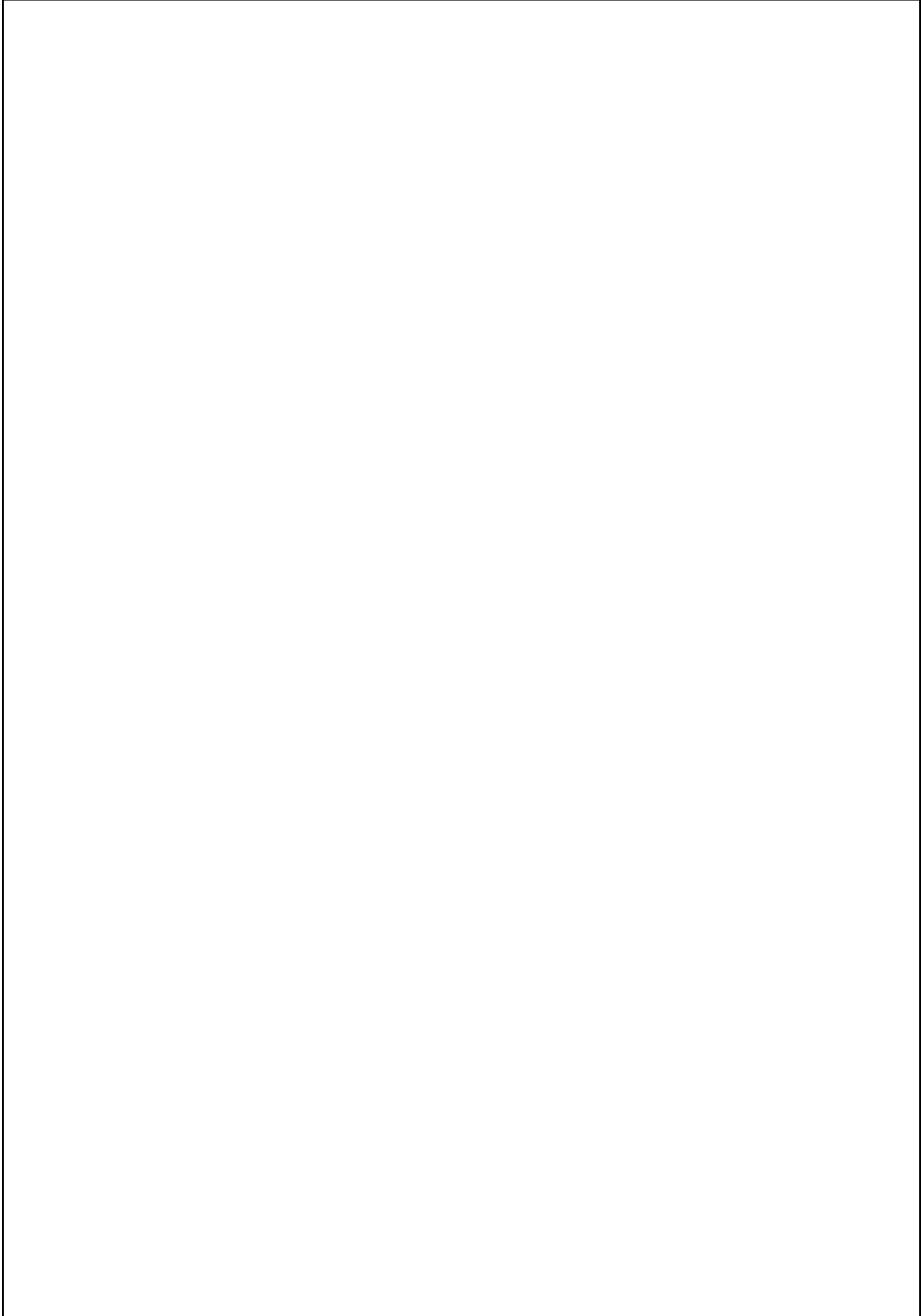
