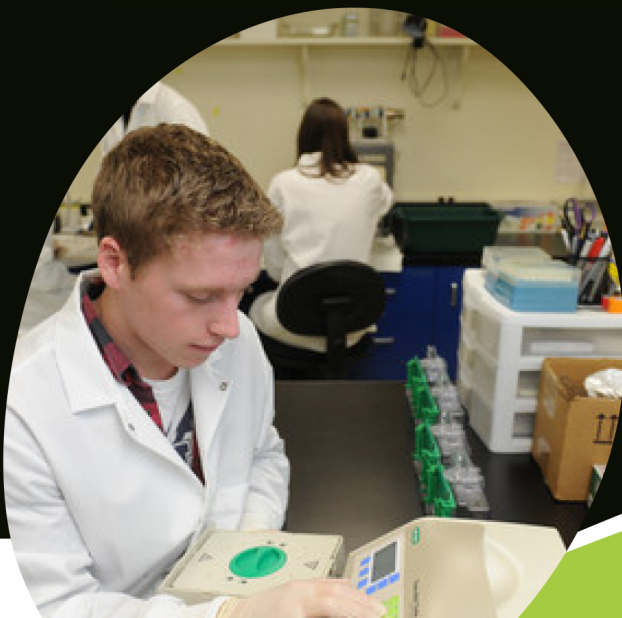


## HOW IT WORKS
