The Gary Hicks Memorial Award was established in 1997 in memory of Dr. Gary Hicks. Gary was a faculty member in the Biology Department at Dalhousie University for 27 years, where he taught developmental and plant biology and played a leading role in running the Honours programme. Gary will long be remembered for his enthusiasm for teaching, his caring nature as an advisor, and his dedication to Biology and biology students.

To perpetuate Gary's memory, the University in conjunction with Gary's family established an annual award to be given to a **student in the Honours programme in Biology or Marine Biology** whose **major area of study is in Plant Science**, and to whom the award will financially assist his/her studies. To this end, the award will be given in the fall semester.
