



Nancy Greenberg Memorial Award

The Nancy Greenberg Memorial Award has been established to recognize the contribution made by a student to the Dalhousie Association of Biology Students (DABS), the Department of Biology and the community at large. This annual award is to be given to a student in a Biology degree Program who has:

1. shown outstanding participation, dedication, and contribution to the Biology Program and to DABS
2. demonstrated strong academic performance
3. declared her/his major as Biology.

The selection of the award winner will be made by the Biology Undergraduate Awards Committee and a non-voting member of the executive of DABS who has not applied for the prize. The prize will be presented at the AGM of DABS in March.
