W. ANDREW MACKAY ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline for Applications – November 30, 2007

Purpose of the Fund

To provide a scholarship for a returning undergraduate student at Dalhousie registered in the Faculty of Architecture, Arts & Social Sciences, Computer Science, Engineering, Health Professions, Management or Science.

Eligibility

- Candidates must have attended Dalhousie for at least one year prior to applying, completed a full course load for two terms (min. 30 credit hours) during the previous year and be currently registered in a full course load (15 credit hours) during the term of application.
- The candidate must hold a minimum 3.30 cumulative Grade Point Average.
- In addition to academic achievement, the candidate will have demonstrated excellence in qualities of leadership, citizenship and/or sportsmanship.
- Nominees are not required to be a familial relation to a Dalhousie alumnus.

Award Value

The number and value of awards vary each year. The anticipated award values for the 2007/08 academic year will be two awards of \$3,000 each.

Procedure

- Candidates will be nominated for the award by the various Departments and Schools.
- The Awards Office will review the nominations and GPAs.
- The Alumni Relations Office will select the scholarship winners on behalf of the Dalhousie Alumni Association.
- The Awards Office will administer the payment to the successful candidates.
