- ESS may be a Major or Honours subject in the BSc Double Major or Combined Honours, with an “Allied Subject” from the Faculty of Science or the Faculty of Computer Science.
- The same course may not be used to satisfy a requirement of both Allied Subjects.
- Students in this degree may complete the Certificate in Communicating Sustainability and/or the Certificate in Food, Agriculture, and Sustainability.
