

## Environment, Sustainability and Society (ESS) Requirements for BSc Double Major

### First Year Requirements:

SUST 1000.06 <i>What is Sustainability?</i> (6 credit hours in fall term, satisfies writing req)	<b>OR</b>	SUST 1400.03 <i>Exploring Sustainability</i> (3 credit hours, online, winter and summer)	
SUST 1001.06 <i>A Sustainable Future</i> (6 credit hours in winter term)			
OR DISP/FYP and at least 3 credit hours 1000-level SUST course (may take only SUST 1400.03)			

### Upper Level Courses:

SUST 2000.06 <i>Local Governance, Citizen Engagement and Sustainability</i> (6 credit hours in fall term)			
SUST 2001.06 <i>Global Environmental Governance</i> (6 credit hours in winter term)			
SUST 3000.03 <i>Environmental Decision-Making</i> (3 credit hours in fall term)

<sup>1</sup> SUST 4001 and SUST 4002 must be completed in consecutive Fall and Winter terms. Credit will not be granted for SUST 4001 without completion of SUST 4002 (it is a “multi-term” course).

<sup>2</sup> Students who complete a Work Term with Sustainability or Science Co-op or Sustainability Work Experience Program may substitute ESS Capstone (SUST 4001 and SUST 4002) with 6 credit hours SUST at 3000-level or above. Students starting their degree prior to September 2024 will require a waiver from the ESS Academic Advisor ([ess.advising@dal.ca](mailto:ess.advising@dal.ca)).

<sup>3</sup> The current list of **ESS Electives** is in the College of Sustainability section of the Academic Calendar.

- ESS may be a Major or Honours subject in the BSc Double Major or Combined Honours, with an “Allied Subject” from the Faculty of Science or the Faculty of Computer Science.
- ESS may also be a Minor in any 120 credit-hour BSc degree (not with ESS as Major or Honours subject).
- The same course may not be used to satisfy a requirement of both Allied Subjects.
