

Society and Culture Research Fund (Publishing Support Program)

The purpose of the fund is to support research initiatives in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. The use of funds for publishing support is designed to assist with the costs associated with translation, indexing, permissions, and the publication of monographs, edited books, or other academic publications.

Normally, the deadline is February 15th, and the maximum amount applicants can request is \$1,500. Formal receipts must be dated within the eligible period (which corresponds to a March to March period ending in the current year). Applicants should also submit up to one page explaining why the funds are needed and a statement on whether other support has been offered.

Allocation of funds is determined by the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Research Development Committee, who will assess applications based on: stage of publication, requests that are at the end stages of publication, as well as potential for academic impact and knowledge translation and mobilization.
